MAIDSTONE CURBSIDE RECYCLING 2018

PAPER: Newspapers, magazines, white paper, junk mail, catalogs, and telephone books, glossy inserts, paperback books, colored paper, wrapping paper, & junk mail can all be mixed together. **NOT ACCEPTED** are Kraft bags, manila envelopes, manila file folders and boxboard.

CARDBOARD: Kraft bags, manila envelopes, manila file folders, brown boxboard and corrugated cardboard. **NOT ACCEPTED** are egg cartons, wax coated cardboard, soiled cardboard, Styrofoam. No strings, excess tape, handles or bags with plastic layers.

Please separate paper and cardboard into 2 bins. Items must be visible.

TIN CANS: Must be rinsed. Labels are okay. Flattening not required. SEPARATE from aluminum cans. (A magnet will stick to tin but not to aluminum).

ALUMINUM: Cans, foil and food trays. Must be rinsed. Labels okay. **NOT ACCEPTED** are snack bags and candy wrappers.

Please separate aluminum and tin into 2 bins. Items must be visible.

GLASS: All colors of bottles and jars. Must be rinsed. Window & mirror glass if broken in smaller pieces. Pyrex and drinking glasses. **NOT ACCEPTED** are crystal, or glass with metal, wood or lids. **NO** light bulbs.

PLASTICS: #'S 1-4. Must be rinsed. Look for the recycling number stamped on the bottom of the container. Includes all labeled rigid plastic containers. Labels are ok. Please crush larger containers. (For example milk jugs). Plastics #'s 4-7 can be set aside and will be accepted on "Bulky Day" from 8 a.m. to noon at 1342 Route 102, Bradley & Cheryl McVetty's residence. Some #2's are not accepted: These include yogurt and cottage containers and some food containers from the deli. Check the number in the triangle. Some plastics from the Deli are #1's. **NOT ACCEPTED** are vinyl siding, Styrofoam, syringes or medical devices – call for proper disposal options for these items. (802) 626-3532 or (800) 734-4602.

All other recyclables not accepted for collection in Maidstone such as Electronics, Clothing and Textiles, Special Wastes (aerosol cans, Agricultural Bale wrap, Alkaline batteries, Automotive Batteries, Cellular Phones, Fluorescent Bulbs, Hard and Soft covered Books, Lead fishing sinkers, Mercury Containing Devices, oil, oil filters, Printer Cartridges, Propane tanks, Rechargeable Batteries, Scrap Metal, and Tires) **are all collected year round in Lyndonville at 224 CHURCH ST., LYNDONVILLE, VT.** The walk-in is open **Wednesday 8 a.m.-4 p.m. & Saturday 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.** Fees apply for tires.

LEAF AND YARD WASTE: Beginning July 1, 2017 these will be banned from the landfills.

FOOD WASTE: Beginning July 2020 food scraps will be banned from the landfills.

Household Hazardous Waste is also collected in Lyndonville at the above address by appointment Monday – Friday, June through the end of September and at special events throughout the District June – September.
